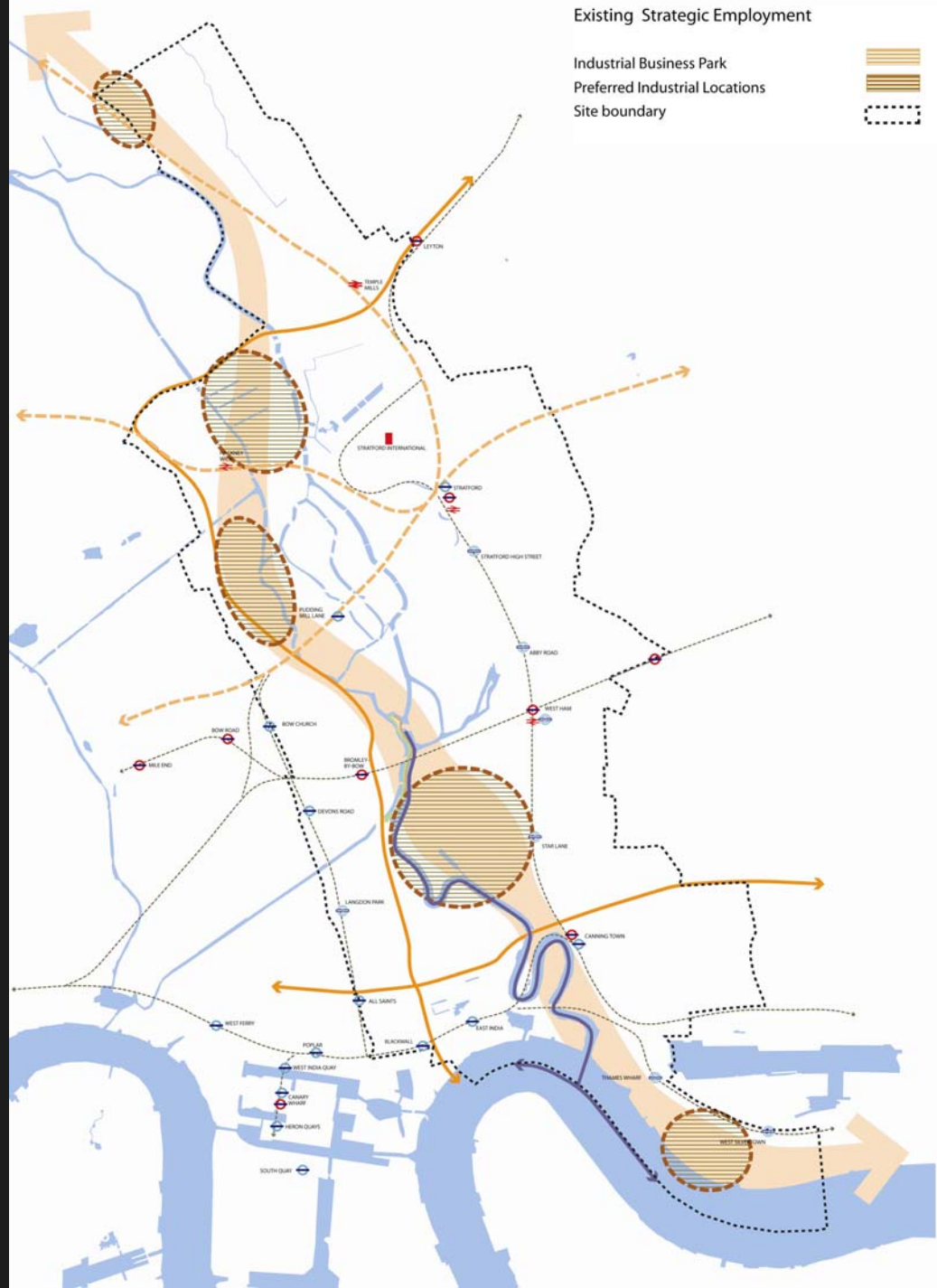

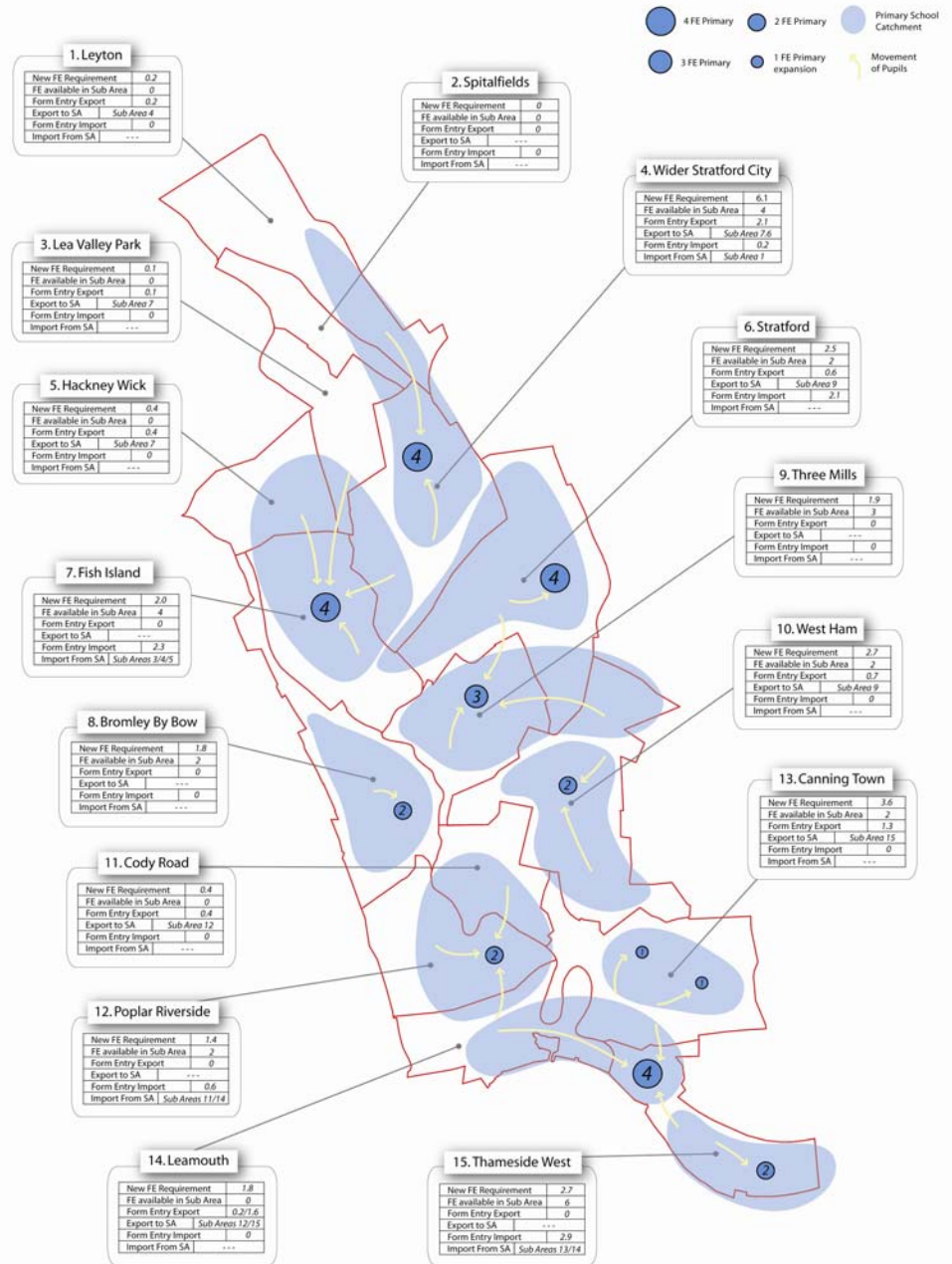
Proposed Housing

- Balancing housing need with social infrastructure, open space, and employment

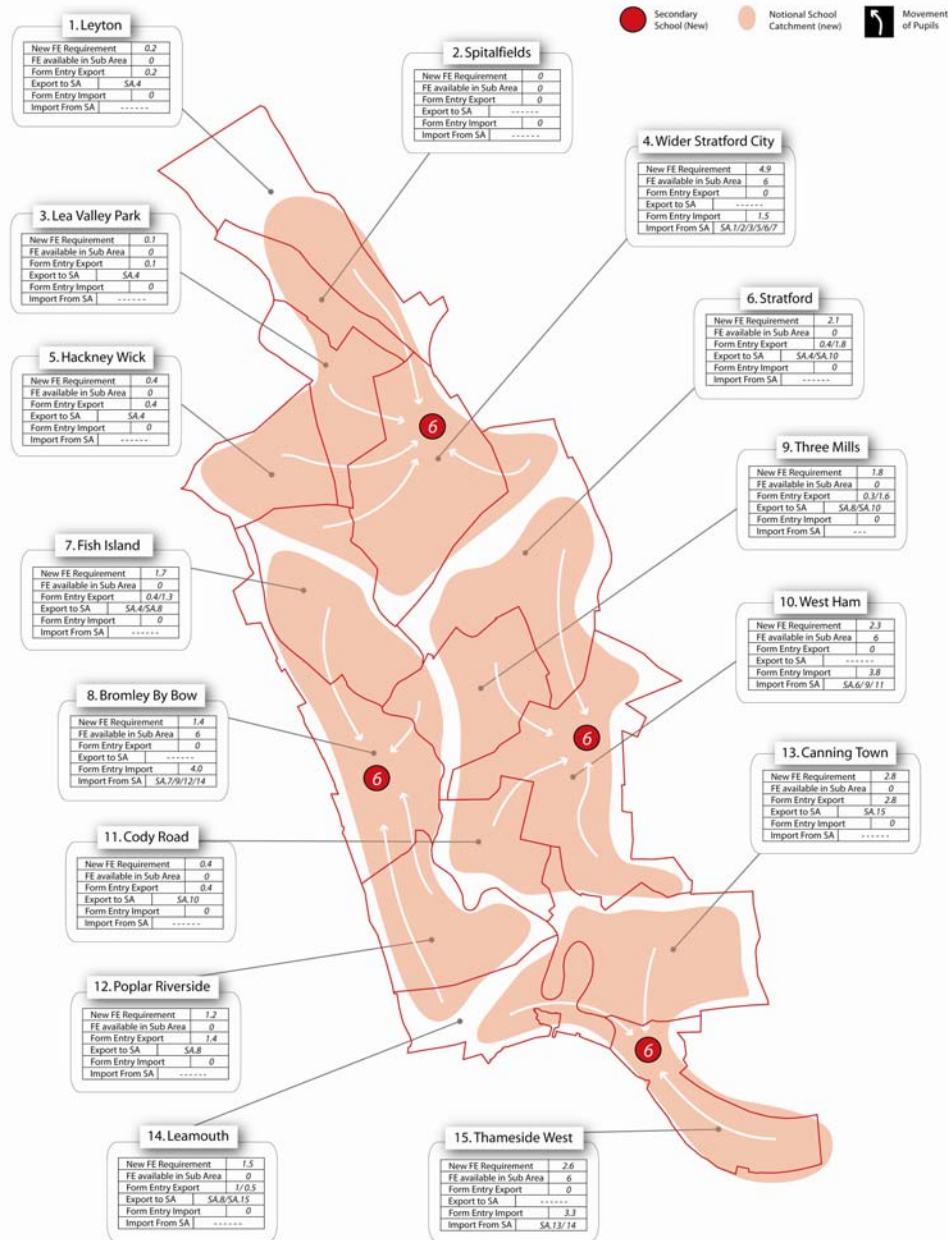
Future Urban Structure



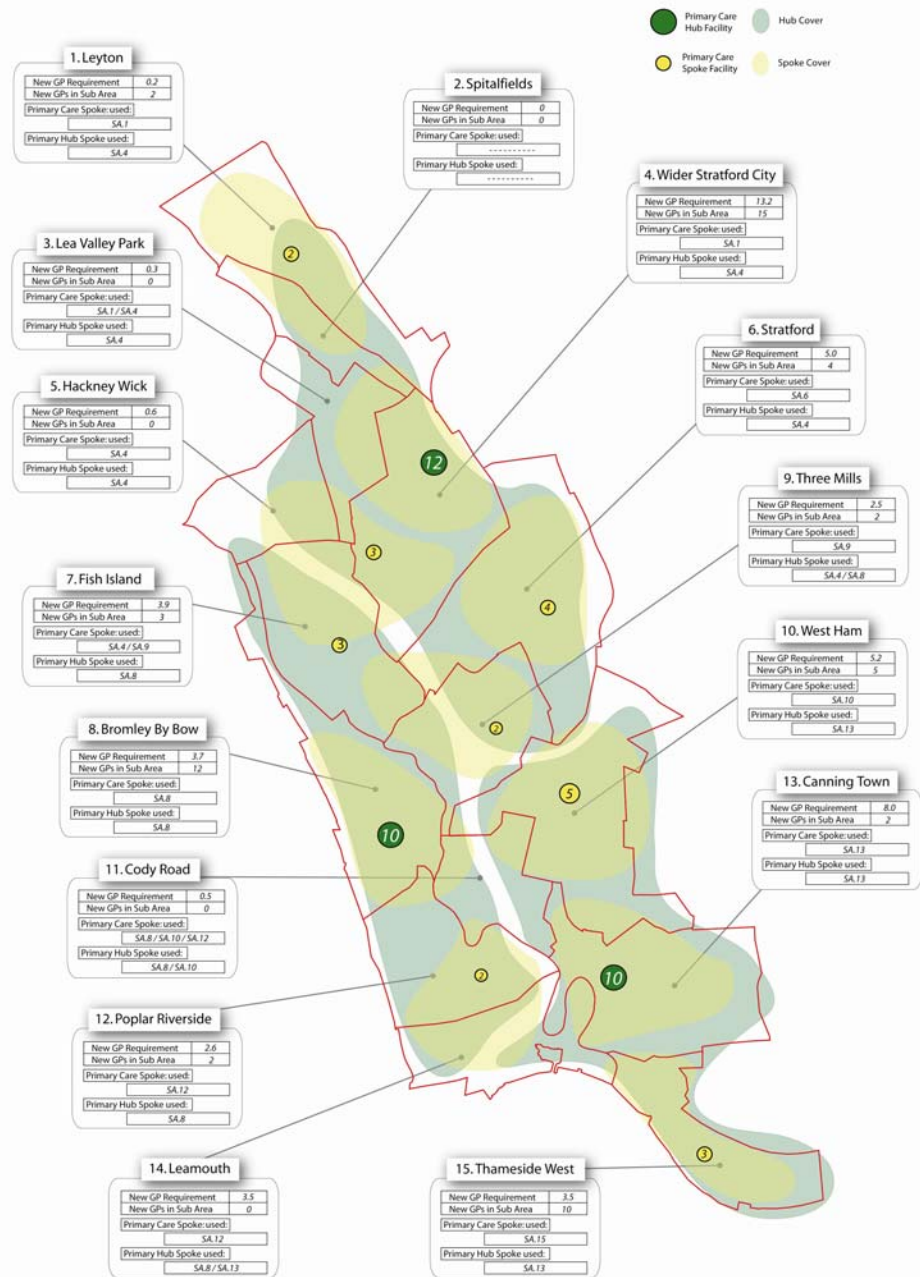
Distribution of Primary Schools



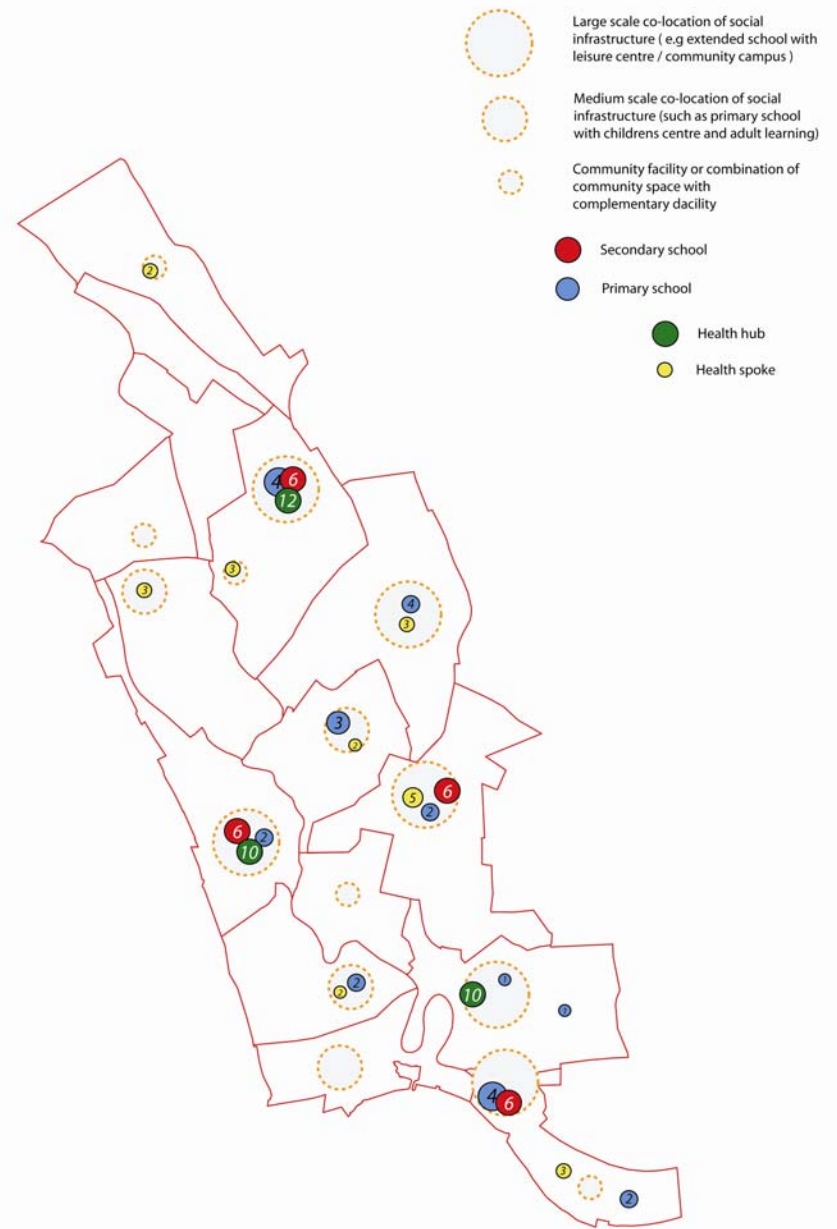
Distribution of Secondary Schools



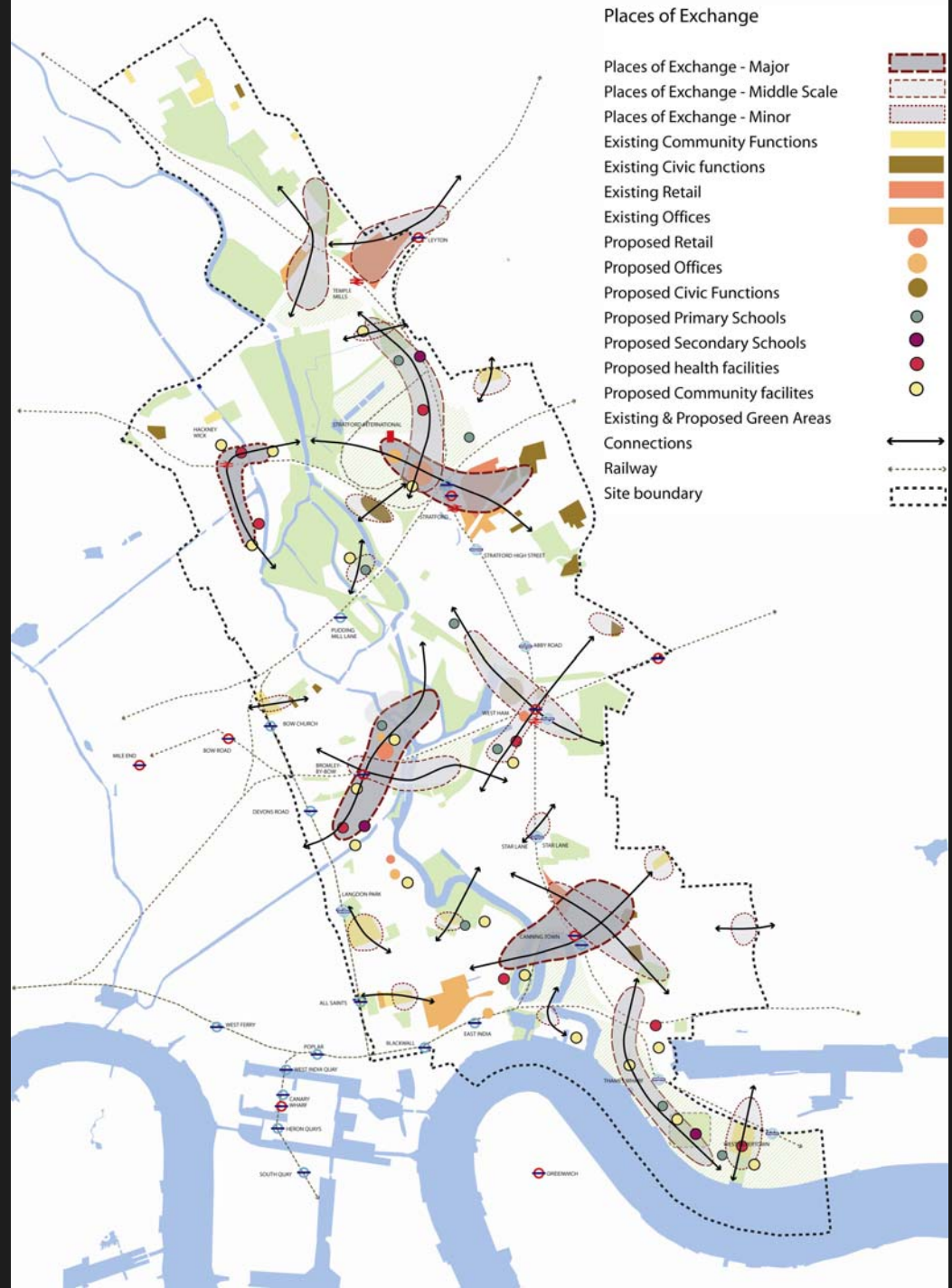
Distribution of Health Facilities



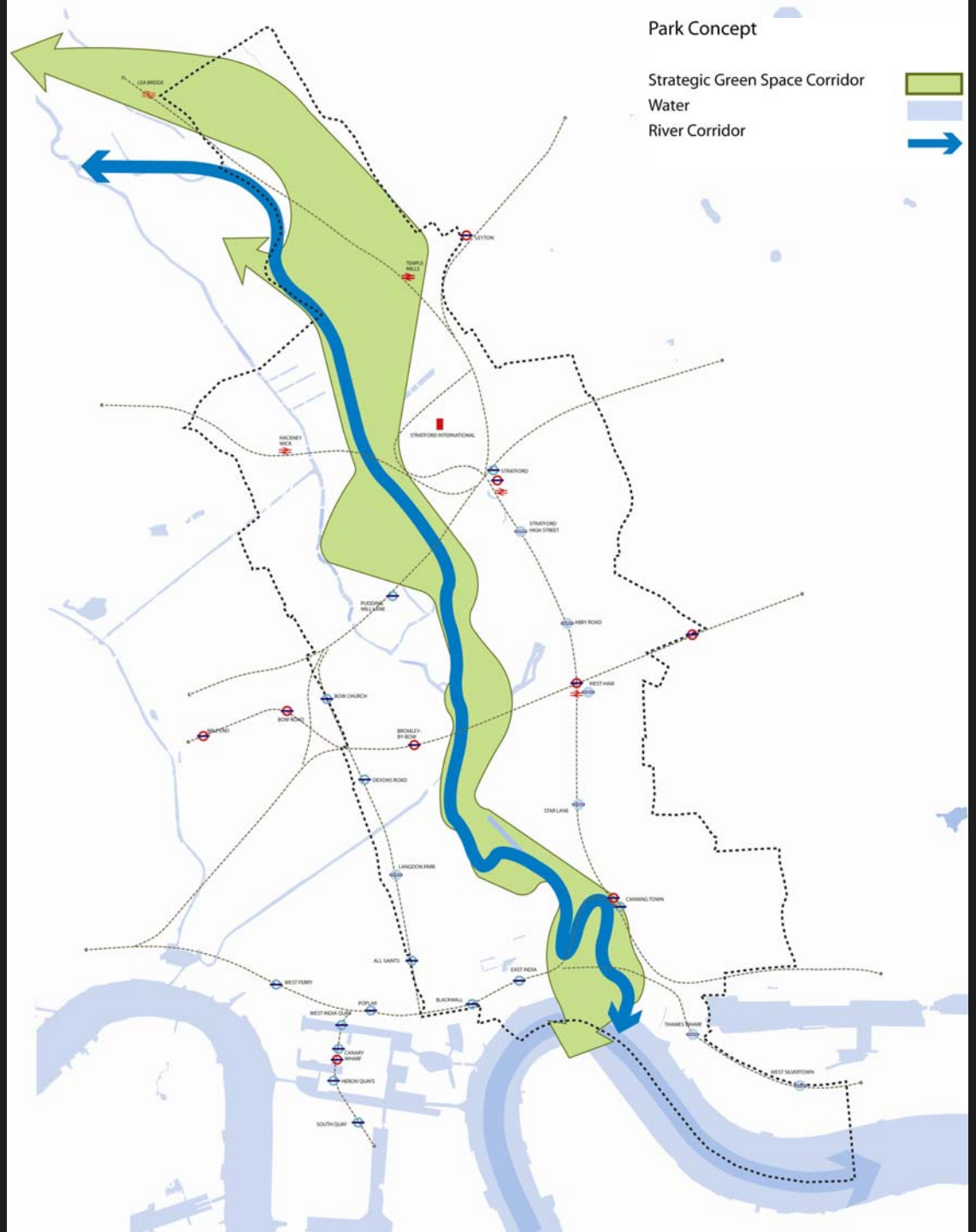
